Learned counsel for the appellant seeks permission to incorporate the provision of law in 1st page of I.A No.97 of 2022 [F.A. No.18 of 2014] in course of the day.

2. Prayer is allowed.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant is directed to incorporate the provision of law by red ink in course of the day.

4. I.A. No.97 of 2022 has been filed for expunging the name of Respondent No.1 namely, Late Ratni Devi, who died sometime in the year 2021.

5. It is submitted that despite best effort the petitioner-appellant could not ascertain the exact date of death of Respondent No.1 namely, late Ratni. It is submitted that Respondent No.1 died leaving behind one Talo Manjhi as her legal heir, who is already on record as Respondent No.2 in this appeal.

6. Mr. Nanhu Ram, learned counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondents and submitted that he has no objection.

7. Learned counsel for the State also raised no objection.

8. It appears that Ratni Devi- Respondent No.1 has died leaving behind one Talo Manjhi, who is already added as Respondent No.2 in this First Appeal.

9. Under the circumstances, let the name of Ratni Devi-Respondent No.1 expunged by red ink.

10. Accordingly, let the name of Ratni Devi-Respondent No.1 be expunged from the column of the respondents by red ink.

11. Office is directed to maintain the record properly.

12. I.A. No.97 of 2022 is allowed and stands disposed of.
