**02/ 18.06.2026:** Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sahibganj P.S. Case No. 27 of 2026, registered under sections 115(2), 126(2), 118(1), 109 (1) and 3(5) of B.N.S, pending in the Court of learned A.C.J.M, Sahibganj.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there are case and counter case between the parties and altercation took place when talk of settlement was going on between husband and wife. He next submits that allegations are made that petitioner no.2 has assaulted Md. Sajeer however injury is said to be simple and further allegation is against Rajeev that he assaulted Shakila pursuant to that she received grievous injury. He submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent which is disclosed in para 19 of the petition. On these grounds, he submits that the petitioners may kindly be provided privilege of anticipatory bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer and submits that allegations of assault are there and pursuant to that injury has been received.

5. Considering that so far injury due to assault made by petitioner no.2 is concerned, that injury was found to be simple. There are general and omnibus allegation against all the accused persons. Due to assault made by Rajeev grievous injury has been received and the said Rajeev is not petitioner in this petition. Further the petitioners have no criminal antecedent which is disclosed in para 19 of the petition.

6. In the attending facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, the above named, petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned court within three weeks from today and in the event of their surrender / arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M, Sahibganj, in connection with Sahibganj P.S. Case No. 27 of 2026, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S, 2023.
