This application has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the trial court has acquitted the petitioner, but the same was overturned by the learned appellate court. It has also been submitted that the petitioner did not get any reasonable opportunity to put forward his case on account of the reversal of his acquittal by the appellate court.

Save and except the merits of the case, no circumstance has been enumerated by the learned counsel for the petitioner which would be suggestive of the fact that the same is an exceptional circumstance to grant exemption to the petitioner in terms of the Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

On consideration of the aforesaid, I am not inclined to allow this application and the same accordingly stands rejected.
