The petitioner has been made accused in connection with S.T. Case No. 54 of 2025 arising out of Kamdara P.S. Case No. 51 of 2024, for the offences registered under Section 103(1) of the B.N.S., 2023, pending in the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-III, Gumla.

On 31.10.2024 at about 6:00 P.M., the informant was present in his house, when the deceased Ashok Dhanwar armed an axe came there and started assaulting her. It is alleged that the petitioner who is the son of the informant snatched the axe from the deceased and gave an axe blow, due to which he succumbed to his injury.

It was submitted that the occurrence has taken place in self-defence. It was further submitted that petitioner has given only one axe blow on the person of the deceased.

In view of the submissions made above, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-III, Gumla, in connection with S.T. Case No. 54 of 2025 arising out of Kamdara P.S. Case No. 51 of 2024.
