This interlocutory application has been preferred by the petitioner praying therein that no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

Submission has been advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner that pursuant to the order dated 09.02.2026 the amount of 20% of the compensation amount has already been deposited by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the amount as directed by this Court in its order dated 09.02.2026 has already been deposited, the same would be a ground to grant exemption to the petitioner to surrender.

The entire averments made in the instant application touches upon the merits of the case and nowhere it has been stated about the willingness of the petitioner to deposit the entire amount or of any exceptional circumstances which would implore this Court to consider grant of exemption to the petitioner. There being absolutely no reasons in support of what has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner, I am not inclined to entertain this interlocutory application, which accordingly, stands rejected.
