02/19.06.2026 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Domchanch P.S. Case No.81 of 2022, registered for the offence under Sections 379, 411, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 21(1), 25(5) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, Rule 54 of JMMC Rules, 2004 and Section 33 of Indian Forest Act, pending in the Court of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Koderma.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not involved in carrying mica scrap and it has been alleged that the bikes were part of carrying the mica scrap. He further submits that now the bike was not belonging to the petitioner and that has already been sold by the petitioner to another person on 26.09.2015. He next submits that the co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in A.B.A. No.9091 of 2022 and A.B.A. No.6028 of 2023. He also submits that the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent, as disclosed in paragraph 19 of this application.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the allegations are there of involvement in collecting the mica scrap against the petitioner.

5. Considering that the co-accused persons have been granted bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in the aforesaid A.B.As. and it has been pointed out that the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent, as disclosed in paragraph 19 of this application and further, the bike was already sold by the petitioner to one Pawan Singh on 26.09.2015 and in the attending facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the above-named petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender, he shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Koderma in connection with Domchanch P.S. Case No.81 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
