1. Heard Mrs. J. Mazumdar, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. as well as Mr. Rajiv Ranjan, learned counsel appearing for the Opposite Party No.2.
2. This application has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of exemption to the petitioner to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.
3. It appears that earlier the petitioner has preferred an application for grant of exemption in I.A. No. 8745 of 2025, but the same was rejected as no exceptional circumstance was pointed out by the petitioner.
4. Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the opposite party no.2 and an amount of Rs.11,00,000/- (eleven lakhs) has already been transferred to the account of the opposite party no.2.
5. Mr. Rajiv Ranjan, learned counsel for the opposite party no.2 has accepted the factum of compromise and the transfer of the cheque amount of Rs. 11,00,000/-.

6. Regard being had to the subsequent development which does indicate that the matter has been compromised and which finds reflection in I.A. No. 7274 of 2026, the same is a sufficient cause for grant of exemption to the petitioner.
7. Accordingly, the petitioner is exempted to surrender before the learned Trial Court in connection with Complaint Case No. 2621 of 2019.
8. This Interlocutory Application stands disposed of.
