2. Learned A.P.P. has submitted that the appellant No. 5 Anil Pandit had died, for which he has also filed the affidavit on 22.08.2022 and enclosed the photocopy of Death Certificate dated 25.05.2022 of the appellant No. 5 namely Anil Pandit as Annexure -A .

3. It appears from the affidavit dated 22.08.2022 has been filed on behalf of the State through one Rajesh Mahli, S/o Late Biswanath Mahli who is working as Assistant Sub Inspector, Fatehpur Police Station, District- Jamtara that the appellant No. 5 Anil Pandit had died on 26.10.2015 and the Death Certificate has been enclosed as Annexure –A to the said affidavit.

4. From perusal of Death Certificate dated 25.05.2022 of the appellant No. 5 Anil Pandit which is issued by the Gram Panchayat Palajori, it appears that the deceased Anil Pandit had died on 26.10.2015 .

5. Thus, the appeal stands abated against the appellant No. 5 Anil Pandit under the provision of 394 of Cr.P.C.

6. Office is directed to delete the name of the appellant No. 5 Anil Pandit by the red ink and shall maintain the record properly.
