However, learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 has submitted that till date nothing has been paid to the opposite party no. 2 by the petitioner.

2. It appears from the impugned judgment that earlier also the wife i.e. opposite party no. 2 had filed Original Maintenance Case No. 62 of 2019 in which the case was compromised by the petitioner. However, the compromise has failed and the opposite party no. 2 was compelled to file Original Maintenance Case No. 86 of 2022, which has been decided vide impugned judgment dated 01.04.2023.

3. It has been informed that the petitioner has not paid any amount to the opposite party nos. 2 and 3 till date.

4. The marriage between the husband and wife is admitted.

5. Under the circumstances, the petitioner is directed to pay Rs. 1,50,000/- to the opposite party no. 2 for survival of the opposite party no. 2 and her child.

6. Put up this case on 30.06.2025.

7. Opposite party no. 2 will be at liberty to place this order before the Controlling Authority of the petitioner.
