The prayer for bail of the appellant was earlier dismissed as not pressed in I.A. No. 6776 of 2022.

It appears that the husband of the Informant was subjected to brutal assault by the appellant in order to grab his land and the factum of assault has been corroborated by the postmortem report as well as by the evidence of witnesses examined during the trial.

In view of the specific nature of allegation against the appellant, we are not inclined to reconsider the prayer for bail of the appellant. Accordingly, his prayer for bail stands rejected, once again.

I.A. No. 10647 of 2023 stands rejected.
