Heard Mr. Ranjan Kumar Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P on behalf of the State.

This application has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

The reason which has been assigned in the instant application is that the petitioner is suffering from Jaundice and therefore, his health condition requires constant rest.

The prescriptions, which have been brought on record, reveal that the petitioner is suffering from jaundice since 17.07.2025 and more than eight months have expired, since the petitioner was afflicted with the said disease. There is no recent prescription to suggest that the petitioner is suffering from any such ailments, which would be a reason for granting him exemption to surrender.

Consequent thereto, I am not inclined to entertain this application, which stands rejected.

The aforesaid I.A. stands rejected.
