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15/30.06.2025 It appears that vide order dated 12.09.2024, the Co-ordinate Bench (Justice Ratnaker Bhengra as then His Lordship was) of this Court had rejected the Interlocutory Application being I. A. No. 6600 of 2024 in Cr. Revision No. 770 of 2023 and I. A. No. 6601 of 2024 in Cr. Revision No. 767 of 2023 filed on behalf of the petitioners Kiran Mishra and Rakesh Kumar Mishra respectively seeking exemption from surrendering before the learned Court below.

2. Thereafter the petitioners have moved before the Hon'ble Supreme Court being Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No (s)- 13728-13729 of 2024 and vide order dated 09.04.2025, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has allowed Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No (s)- 13728-13729 of 2024 by exempting the petitioners Kiran Mishra (Cr. Revision No. 770 of 2023) and Rakesh

Kumar Mishra (Cr. Revision No. 767 of 2023) from surrendering before the learned Court below.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioner- Rakesh Kumar Mishra (Cr. Revision No. 767 of 2023) is ready for one time settlement with opposite party no. 2.
4. Lower Court Records have already been received.
5. Under the circumstances, these cases will be heard on their own merit.
6. Put up these cases on 25.08.2025.
7. Parties may seek instruction on the point of compromise.
