2. A petition seeking exemption from surrender has been filed in both these cases.
3. The learned counsel for the opposite party no.2 has vehemently opposed the petition and has submitted that a counter affidavit has been filed opposing the prayer. He has referred to the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in **(2015) 12 SCC 86 (Vivek Rai and another Vs. High Court of Jharkhand and others)** to submit that no exceptional circumstances have been brought on record to allow exemption from surrender.
