Heard Mr. A. K. Choudhary, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P on behalf of the State as well as Mr. Niranjana Kumar, learned counsel for the opposite party No.2.

This application has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is suffering from Fatty liver as well as Kidney ailments and he is highly diabetic, having been suggested to take insulin injections three times a day. It has further been submitted that pursuant to the order passed by the learned Sessions Judge in Appeal, the petitioner has also deposited 20% of the compensation amount.

Learned A.P.P as well as learned counsel for the opposite party No.2 have opposed the prayer of the petitioner in this application.

The various medical prescriptions which have been brought on record does suggests that the petitioner is suffering from several ailments and on account of his highly diabetic condition, his kidney also seems to have been affected.

On consideration of the aforesaid facts, the same being an exceptional circumstance, the petitioner is exempted to surrender before the learned Trial Court in connection with P.C.R. Case No.526/2012 & T.R. No.08/2023.

The aforesaid I.A. stands disposed of.
