2. This Contempt Petition has been preferred by the petitioner against non-compliance of order dated 28.04.2025 passed in W.P.(S) No.6909 of 2024.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel representing the opposite party – State, that the amount has been disbursed.

4. Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that though the amount has been paid, there may be some discrepancy in the quantum. He submits that liberty may be given to the petitioner to raise his grievance before the appropriate Forum, if any discrepancy arises in quantum.

5. In view of the aforesaid submission, this Contempt Proceeding is **dropped**.

6. However, the petitioner is at liberty to raise his grievance before the appropriate Forum, if he is aggrieved by the quantum.
