1. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the only allegation assigned to the petitioner is advancing an amount to Rs.3crore 40 lakhs to the son of the accused Shailesh Kumar Singh for purchase of a land and the petitioner does not have any involvement with respect to the preparation of false documents which has been alleged against other accused persons including Shailesh Kumar Singh.

It has been submitted that this application has been preferred against the order of discharge and the connected matter being Criminal Revision No. 14528 of 2026 has been filed against the order framing charge.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that tomorrow is the date fixed for producing the witnesses, and in such circumstances, he has pressed I.A. No.9378 of 2026 and has submitted that further proceedings in the trial court as far as the petitioner is concerned be stayed.

2. Mr. Achyut Keshave learned Senior Advocate Addl. General prays for an adjournment as he has to go through the records of the case.

3. In view of the above, list these cases **21st, July 2026** at the top of the board.

4. Till that date, further proceeding in connection with CID Court Case No. 14 of 2025 arising out of CID PS Case No.4 of 2025, pending in the court of learned AJC-XVIII-cum-Special Judge, CID, Ranchi so far as petitioner is concerned shall remain stayed.
