18/06.07.2026 On 16.06.2026 an order was passed to give the possession of the auction property to the petitioner as auction sale has already been concluded.

2. The said interim order was challenged in Letters Patent Appeal (Filing) No. 7292 of 2026, wherein the Division Bench of this Court in paragraph 9 has held that the successful auction purchasers are entitled to receive the delivery of property within a reasonable period unless the same is interdicted by any judicial order. Thereafter, the Letters Patent Appeal was dismissed.

3. Now, it has been submitted that the possession of the property has been handed over to the petitioner on 03.07.2026.

4. Considering the aforesaid submission, since the relief as sought for by the petitioner, has already been granted, this writ petition is **dismissed**, as the same has become infructuous.

5. Pending, interlocutory applications, if any, stand **disposed of**.
