2. The learned counsel for the respondents is permitted to file reply to the petition for condonation of delay in F.A. No.303 of 2026 during the court proceedings, which is taken on record. He submits that so far as other cases are concerned, reply to the interlocutory application for condonation of delay will be filed prior to the next date and the matter be listed in the next week.

3. Reply to the interlocutory application for condonation of delay, if not already filed, be filed latest by 27.08.2026, failing which the petition seeking condonation of delay will be taken upon without waiting further for the reply to the interlocutory applications.
