2. This application has been preferred by the appellant for grant of provisional bail to him on account of the death of his father on 01.09.2026.

3. It has been submitted by the learned Counsel for the appellant that the appellant has to attend the last rituals of his father and therefore, he has prayed for grant of provisional bail.

4. Learned Spl. P.P. vide order dated 09.09.2026 was directed to take instruction with respect to the averments made in the instant application and she has submitted that the father of the appellant has, indeed, died on 01.09.2026.

5. Regard being had to the above, we are inclined to admit the appellant on provisional bail for a period of 15 days from today. Accordingly, during the pendency of this appeal, the appellant is directed to be released on provisional bail for a period of 15 days on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount

each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, POCSO Act, Giridih in connection with POCSO Case No. 61/2019, arising out of Tisri P.S. Case No. 30/2019, subject to the condition that the appellant shall surrender before the learned Trial Court on or before 28th of September, 2026.

6. Let this matter be listed on 12th of October, 2026 under the heading '**For Orders**' so that in the meantime, learned Counsel for the appellant files a supplementary affidavit indicating that the appellant has surrendered pursuant to this order.

7. This Interlocutory Application stands disposed of.
