2. Petitioner has been made accused in connection with S.T. No. 544 of 2024 arising out of Ormanjhi P.S. Case No. 18 of 2024 for the offences registered under Sections 307, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act, pending in the Court of learned Additional Judicial Commissioner-V, Ranchi.

3. On 06.02.2024, at about 12:00 noon, two unknown persons had fired at the workplace of the informant to enforce the demand of *rangdari*.

4. It was submitted that the petitioner is neither named in the F.I.R., nor he was put on test identification parade. It was further submitted that the name of the petitioner has transpired in the confession of co-accused. It was finally submitted that several co-accused persons have been granted bail by this Court as well as by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

5. In view of the submission made above, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Judicial Commissioner-V, Ranchi, in connection with S.T. No. 544 of 2024 arising out of Ormanjhi P.S. Case No. 18 of 2024.
