Perused the explanation sent by Ms. Manju Kumari, learned Addl. Sessions Judge-V-cum-FTC (CAW), Jamshedpur, vide letter no.537/2025 dated 14.11.2025 by which the learned Addl. Sessions Judge has tendered her apology for granting permanent bail to the appellant instead of provisional bail.

2. She has stated and submitted that this mistake has occurred accidentally and it was inadvertent and further submitted that she will not commit such type of mistake in future again.

3. Under the circumstances, the explanation furnished by Ms. Manju Kumari, learned Addl. Sessions Judge-V-cum-FTC (CAW), Jamshedpur is accepted for the present with a direction to remain careful in future.

4. Although, Office has reported that a notice was issued upon Respondent No.2 but the same has been returned unserved, with the endorsement “no such person at address”. However,

6. In the meantime, it will be open to the learned counsel for the Informant to take necessary step.
