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**02 /09.09.2025:** The claim of the petitioners is that their candidature for the post of Sahayak Acharya (class 6 to 8) should be considered as they have participated in the recruitment process which was conducted by the Jharkhand Staff Selection Commission pursuant to Advertisement No. 13/2023 and they have requisite qualification but they have not been considered. In paragraph no. 8 of the writ petition they have stated that petitioner no. 1 has secured 236 marks, petitioner no. II secured 206 marks and petitioner no. III secured 223 marks in their category as per self-assessment on the basis of response-sheet. As per the petitioner, they have obtained more marks than the qualifying marks but they have not been called for document verification though the candidates who have received lesser marks have been selected and called for document verification.

**2.** Considering the aforesaid fact, I direct the JSSC to file a short affidavit indicating the marks which the petitioners have obtained in their category and the marks of last selected candidates in their category.
