Heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties.

2. Bail application of the petitioner was earlier rejected by this court vide order dated 30th April, 2026 in B.A. No. 11940 of 2025.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it has been mentioned in the bail order that 10 FIRs related to cyber offence has been registered against the petitioner. He submits that he could not find out any such FIR. As per his knowledge, the same was at best crime links. He also submits that except this case, no other case has been registered against the petitioner and the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.
4. Learned counsel for the opposite party-State is directed to file a counter affidavit clarifying the aforesaid position that if any FIR has been registered in the State of Jharkhand or in any other State in connection with the crime link. The details of the FIR and the police station should be mentioned in the counter affidavit.
5. Post this case on 20.08.2026.
6. The counter affidavit should be filed by 14.08.2026.
