2. The petitioner has been made accused in connection with S.T. No. 94 of 2025 arising out of Masalia P.S. Case No. 66 of 2024 for the offences registered under Section 311 of the B.N.S. 2023 and Section 27 of the Arms Act and cognizance has been taken for the offences under Sections 309(2), 311, 103(1), 55, 56 of the B.N.S., 2023 and Sections 25(1-B)(a), 26, 35, 27 of the Arms Act, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-II, Dumka.

3. On 28.12.2024 at about 6:00 p.m., husband of the informant was waylaid by three unknown persons between Tasariya and Ajmeri More. It is alleged that the accused persons murdered the husband of the informant and looted his jewelleryes and money.

4. It was submitted that petitioner is neither named in the F.I.R. nor he was put on T.I. Parade. It was further submitted that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner.

5. Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State has submitted that a pistol is said to have been recovered from possession of the petitioner.

6. F.S.L. report with regard to seized murder weapon was called for from the learned Trial Court. The learned Trial Court has reported that the seized weapon has not been sent to F.S.L. for examination.

7. In view of the aforesaid facts, I am inclined to release the petitioner, on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-II, Dumka, in connection with S.T. No. 94 of 2025 arising out of Masalia P.S. Case No. 66 of 2024.
