Perusal of the record reveals that notice issued to the opposite party nos. 8, 10, 11, 21, 23, 26, 33, 34, 40, 56, 70, 75, 76, 87, 91, 92, 94, 98, 104, 106, 107, 121 and 117 has returned with the report that they have died since long.

The petitioner is directed to file a supplementary affidavit mentioning therein the dates on which the opposite party nos. 8, 10, 11, 21, 23, 26, 33, 34, 40, 56, 70, 75, 76, 87, 91, 92, 94, 98, 104, 106, 107, 121 and 117 have died.

It is made clear that if the said supplementary affidavit is not filed within six weeks, this civil miscellaneous petition shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Bench.

Notice issued to the opposite party nos. 3, 15, 47, 53, 82, 84, 85 and 105 has returned unserved.

Issue fresh notice to the opposite party nos. 3, 15, 47, 53, 82, 84, 85 and 105.

The petitioner is directed to file fresh requisites for service of notice on the opposite party nos. 3, 15, 47, 53, 82, 84, 85 and 105 by registered post with A/D as well as under ordinary process within six weeks failing which; this civil miscellaneous petition shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Bench.

Rule is made returnable within six weeks.

List this civil miscellaneous petition after receipt of the service report of the notice issued to the opposite party nos. 3, 15, 47, 53, 82, 84, 85 and 105.
