This interlocutory application has been preferred by the appellant for grant of bail to him during the pendency of this appeal.

The appellant has been convicted for the offences under Sections 376 and 302 of the Indian Penal Code and has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life alongwith a fine of Rs.10,000/-.

It has been alleged that the wife of the informant was subjected to rape by the appellant and she was also assaulted by him causing severe injuries on her private parts. The post-mortem report reveals the injuries sustained by the victim on her private parts and there has been an oral dying declaration of the deceased.

Regard being had to the nature of the offence, we are not inclined to admit the appellant on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the appellant is hereby, rejected at this stage.

The aforesaid I.A. stands rejected.
