This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

The reason which has been assigned in the instant application is that the petitioner is suffering from certain ailments and therefore, he be exempted to surrender.

In support of the contention advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner, certain medical prescriptions have been brought on record, from which, it appears that the petitioner is suffering from high cholesterol as well as palpitation and none of the ailment suffered by the petitioner could be construed to be a sufficient cause for granting him exemption to surrender.

In view thereof, this application stands rejected.
