Heard the parties.

Learned Advocate General informs us that in view of the fact that he was outside the State, has not been able to make a consultation with the stakeholders of the State Government, thus, more time would be required.

Since the original file would be required during the discussion by the State authorities with the learned Advocate General, let the office scan the record to keep it under sealed cover under safe custody to be produced on the next date of hearing and original file be returned to the learned Advocate General.

Mr. V. P. Singh, learned senior counsel amicus curie has submitted before us that due to rigors of the unjustified and unreasonable enhancement of the Court Fee, the litigants would have to suffer during the period when this matter would remain pending and especially in view of the fact that thirteen districts have been declared as schedule districts and the people of the State of Jharkhand are poor and many of them belong to

Schedule Tribes, some interim order is required to be passed in this matter.

In the above view of the matter, for the time being, we are passing this order to the effect that filing of the Court Fee by the litigants at the enhanced rate shall be subject to result of this writ petition.

As prayed by the learned Advocate General, let this matter be listed on 07.09.2022 at the top of the list.
