Dr. Gurucharan Sahu, Registrar, Ranchi University, Ranchi is  
physically present before this Court. A show cause affidavit has also  
been filed on his behalf.

**2.** Mr. Amit Kumar Sinha, learned counsel for the opposite party no. 3 (wrongly mentioned as opposite party no. 2 in the show cause affidavit dated 28.01.2026), submits that the payment of all the revisional benefits admissible to Late Amulya Kumar Ghosh (the husband of the petitioner) was already made to the petitioner in the year 2024. However, so far as the difference of salary on pay revision is concerned, since the petitioner's husband had retired on 31.05.2001 from Tata College, Chaibasa under Kolhan University, the opposite party no. 3 vide letter dated 24.01.2026 has requested the opposite party no. 2 i.e., the Registrar, Kolhan University, Chaibasa to make available the details of the arrears of salary etc. to him so as to comply the order of this Court.

**3.** Mr. Sharon Toppo, AC to Dr. Ashok Kumar Singh, learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 assures the Court that the required information as sought by the opposite party no. 3 vide

letter dated 24.01.2026 shall be furnished to him positively within two weeks.

**4.** Considering the said submission, put up this case under the heading "For Orders" on 20.02.2026.

**5.** In the meantime, the opposite party no. 2 and the opposite party no. 3 shall ensure that the payment of difference of salary on pay revision of the petitioner's husband is paid to her and the compliance affidavits are filed.

**6.** The personal appearance of the opposite party no. 3 is dispensed with until further orders.
