6.     Let the case-diary along with its enclosures in connection with Jamtara Cyber Crime P.S. Case No. 34 of 2026 be called for from the court of learned Special Judge, Cyber Crime, Jamtara. Let a report with regard to present stage of the case be also called for from the

learned court concerned.

7. Both the cases arise out of the same First Information Report and accordingly, they are tagged together.

8. Post these cases on 07<sup>th</sup> October, 2026.

9. Mr. Shailendra Kumar Tiwari, the learned Spl. P.P. undertakes to communicate this order to the concerned APPs.
