I.A. No. 3563 of 2025:

1. Learned counsel for both the parties have raised the grievance that although this Court has passed an order in Criminal Appeal (DB) No. 627 of 2023 on 08.09.2023 to supply the copy of the trial court record but particularly the learned counsel for the respondent-State has submitted that the copy of the trial court record has not been sent to the office of the learned Advocate General.

Similar is the situation with the learned counsel for the appellant.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that unless the Court will pass the order to supply the trial court record, the same will not be supplied.
3. This Court has verified the aforesaid submission from the office note from which it is evident that the copy of the trial court record has not been supplied.
4. This Court has passed the order to supply the copy of the trial court record at the stage of 389(1) Cr.P.C., the stage of suspension of sentence, but even then, the said order is not been complied with.
5. Learned Registrar General of this Court is directed to look into the matter as to why the copy of the trial court record is not being supplied to the learned counsel for the parties.

6. Let this matter be listed on 15.04.2025 along with the aforesaid explanation to be submitted by the learned Registrar General.
