Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No.632 of 2025(N) registered for the offences punishable under sections 21(b), 22(b), 23, 25 of the N.D.P.S. Act and under Section 111(2)(b) of the B.N.S., 2023.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner was involved in sale and purchase of brown sugar which is also known as heroin and 82.19 gram of brown sugar, which comes under intermediate quantity, was recovered from the co-accused persons. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are all false and no incriminating materials has been recovered from the petitioner. It is next submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 10.07.2026, as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 11 of the bail application. It is further submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial of the case and further undertakes that he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case. It is also submitted that the co-accused person has already been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 27.04.2026 in B.A. No. 3483 of 2026. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be admitted to bail.

The learned Spl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the fact as discussed above, I am inclined to enlarge the above-named petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Commissioner-cum-Special Judge, NDPS, Ranchi, in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No.632 of 2025(N) with the condition that the petitioner will co-operate with the trial of the case and will furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case, with further condition that he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
