This application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

Reference has been made by the learned counsel for the petitioner to the evidence of the complainant as well as the fact that the petitioner is an aged person who is willing to settle the dispute.

There does not appear to be any exceptional circumstance which has been mentioned in this Interlocutory Application and mere willingness to settle the dispute cannot be termed to be an exceptional circumstance to grant exemption to the petitioner to surrender.

Consequent to the above, this Interlocutory Application stands dismissed.
