Learned counsel for the opposite party-State submits that in another contempt matter involving a similar issue, the case has been posted on *15.07.2026* with the condition that if the stay order is not produced on the next date of hearing, **Form-1** shall be issued.

In the present case also, Opposite Party No. 6 was directed to appear before this Court through video conferencing.

Pursuant to the last order, Opposite Party No. 6 is present through video conferencing. However, once again the same plea has been taken that in the similar matter an LPA is pending. It is admitted that no stay has been granted even in that matter, and in the instant case, no LPA has been filed.

Having regard to the aforesaid submissions, it is specifically directed that the order be complied with in true letter and spirit, subject to the final outcome of the LPA, if filed, or alternatively, the stay order be produced. Failing which, **Form-1** shall be issued on the next date of hearing.
