2. Petitioner has been made accused in connection with Pakur (T) P.S. Case No. 176 of 2025 for the offences registered under Sections 310(2) and 311 of the B.N.S., 2023, pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pakur.

3. On 16.06.2025 at about 9.20 pm, dacoity was committed in the house of the informant.

4. It was submitted that the petitioner is neither named in the F.I.R., nor he was put on test identification parade. It was further submitted that though Rs. 8600/- has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner, but the same belongs to him. It was further submitted that similarly situated co-accused persons, Rinku Rajvar and Manjarul Sekh, have been granted bail by this Court.

5. Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that some of the looted articles have been recovered from the possession of co-accused person, which were identified in test identification parade.

6. In view of the aforesaid facts, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pakur, in connection with Pakur (T) P.S. Case No. 176 of 2025.
