1. In this writ petition, grievance of the petitioners is that in the rent receipts issued, the Khasra number of the petitioners have been shown as "000".
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there cannot be a Khasra with a number "000". He further submits that the areas have been shown clearly and rent is also being accepted.

3. Considering the said submissions, I direct the petitioners to approach the Circle Officer, Namkum along with the documents.
4. Once the petitioner approaches the aforesaid authority, Circle Officer, Namkum, will consider the application of the petitioner and match the Online Entry along with Offline Physical Records, and if necessary, will make necessary corrections.
5. It is made clear that while doing so, the Circle Officer, Namkum, will take into consideration the judgment passed by this Court in the case of ***Ram Prakash Bhagat @ Ram Prakash Oraon Vs. State of Jharkhand*** passed in ***W.P.(C). No. 3953 of 2026***.
6. The entire process should be concluded within a period of six weeks from the date of the receipt of the copy of this order.
7. Accordingly, this writ petition stands ***disposed of***.
