Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with
Latehar P.S. Case No. 77 of 2026 registered for the offences punishable
under Sections 109(1), 3(5) of the B.N.S., 2023 and Section 27 of the
Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation
against the petitioner is that the petitioner in furtherance of common
intention with the co-accused persons attempted to murder the
personnels deputed at the entry and exit point of the Tubed Coal Mine
Project area. It is next submitted that the allegation against the
petitioner is false. It is then submitted that no person has sustained
injury in the alleged occurrence. It is further submitted that the
petitioner has been in custody since 14.05.2026 as mentioned in para-18
of the instant bail application. It is next submitted that though
petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.; without putting him on test
identification Parade, charge-sheet has been submitted against him,
and the next date fixed to hearing on the point of charge. It is lastly
submitted that the petitioner undertakes to co-operate with the trial of
the case and also undertakes not to annoy or disturb the witnesses of

the case in any manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Latehar in connection with Latehar P.S. Case No. 77 of 2026 **with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.**
