02/ 10.09.2026: Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 110 of 2026, registered under sections 316(2), 318(4), 61(2)/3(5) of BNS, pending in the Court of learned C.J.M, Chatra.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner no. 1 is maternal grandfather and petitioner no.2 is maternal uncle of one Md. Wasim whose marriage was fixed with the daughter of the informant. He next submits that for negotiation of marriage the petitioners have gone to the house of informant and have taken food and apart from that there is no allegation against the petitioners. On these grounds, he submits that the petitioners may kindly be provided privilege of anticipatory bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer and submits that allegations are there that petitioners are related with Md. Wasim.

5. On perusal of F.I.R, it transpires that only allegation against the petitioners is that they have gone to the house of informant and have taken food. The petitioner no.1 is maternal grandfather and petitioner no.2 is maternal uncle of one Md. Wasim.

6. In the attending facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined

to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, the above named, petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned court within three weeks from today and in the event of their surrender / arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M, Chatra, in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 110 of 2026, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S, 2023.
