05/ 05.02.2025 This appeal has been preferred against the direction of the learned Tribunal of recovery of the awarded amount from the appellant, who happened to be the owner of the pick-up van, which was involved in the accident.

2. Relying on Section 147(1) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, learned counsel appearing for the appellant submits that the said vehicle was involved in the accident, the liability is fastened upon the appellant. It has been pointed out that this appeal is pending and execution case is instituted and in the execution case, the appellant is being pressurized to comply the award and for stay of the proceeding I.A. No. 774 of 2025 has been filed.

3. Mr. Alok Lal, learned counsel usually appears for Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Co. Ltd. and who is present in the court, as such, the court has requested him to accept notice on behalf of respondent No. 1.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant will serve two copies of the memo of appeal as well as the I.A. upon Mr. Lal by tomorrow.

5. Mr. Alok Lal, learned counsel will take instruction in the matter and assist the court on the next date of listing.

6. Let notice be issued to respondent Nos. 2 to 4 in the memo of appeal as well as in the I.A., which is meant for stay of proceeding, through registered cover with A/D as also by ordinary process, for which, requisites etc. must be filed within one week.

7. Let the name of Mr. Alok Lal, learned counsel be reflected in the cause list as a counsel for the insurance company henceforth.
