Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with
Lawalong P.S. Case No. 11 of 2020 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation
against the petitioner is that the petitioner has committed robbery and
looted cash, mobile phone handset and motorcycle of the informant. It
is next submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is false. It is
then submitted that though the petitioner is not named in the FIR but
without putting him on T.I. Parade as mentioned in para-16 of the
instant bail application, charge sheet has been submitted against the
petitioner for having committed dacoity. It is also submitted that the
petitioner has been implicated in this case only on the basis of the
confessional statement of the co-accused persons. It is further
submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 20.06.2026 as
mentioned in para-17 of the instant bail application. It is lastly
submitted that the petitioner undertakes to co-operate with the trial of
the case and also undertakes not to annoy or disturb the witnesses of

the case in any manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Chatra in connection with Lawalong P.S. Case No. 11 of 2020 **with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.**
