2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Mahila P.S. Case No. 14 of 2026, registered for the offence under
Sections 75(2), 78(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 115(2), 74 and 3(5) of
Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, pending in the court of learned Judicial
Magistrate, 1st Class, Jamshedpur.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and there are case
and counter case between the parties. He next submits that false
allegations are made of making assault. On these grounds, he submits
that anticipatory bail may kindly be provided to the petitioner.

4. Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer and submits that
serious allegations are there of teasing the informant since the year
2023. On this ground, he submits that anticipatory bail may kindly be
rejected.

5. In the FIR, it has been alleged that the petitioner followed
the victim and used abusive language against her while going to
college and tuition and also teased her. It has further come that the
victim has complained about the same to the police and upon

intervention of the police, she has compromised the matter, thereafter again the petitioner has started the same thing and allegations are further made of using the filthy language and further the allegations are there of making assault upon the father of the informant.

6. In the attending facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.
