counsel for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Golmuri P.S. Case No.65 of 2026 dated 29.05.2026, registered for the offence
under Sections 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109(1), 303(2), 308(5),
351(2), 352 and 3(5) of the BNS, pending in the Court of the learned Judicial
Magistrate, 1 st Class, Jamshedpur.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. He further submits that the
name of the petitioner has come on confessional statement. He then submits
that even the injury is found to be simple. He next submits that the petitioner
is a student of UG-BBA, Pimpri Chinchwad University, Maharashtra. He also
submits that the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent, as disclosed in
paragraph 15 of this application and co-accused has been granted
anticipatory bail in A.B.A. No. 4511 of 2026.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and
submits that the allegations are there that the petitioner was also present
along with others. On these grounds, she submits that the prayer for
anticipatory bail may kindly be rejected.

5. Considering that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name has come on confessional statement and the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent and it has been pointed out that the petitioner is a student, which is fortified in light of Annexure-2 and petitioner is having no criminal antecedent, as disclosed in paragraph 15 of this application and co-accused has been granted anticipatory bail in the aforesaid A.B.A and in the attending facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the above-named petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender, he shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jamshedpur in connection with Golmuri P.S. Case No.65 of 2026, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
