1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned counsel for the State.

2. The applicant, who is in custody since 17.01.2025, has approached this Court through JHCLSC, Ranchi, for grant of regular bail in connection with Sisai P.S. Case No.120 of 2024, corresponding to G.R. No.251 of 2025, registered for the offence under Section 309(4) of the BNS, 2023.

3. *It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant that complete set of F.I.R along with its enclosures have been annexed with the present bail application and there is no suppression on his/ her part.*

Innocence of the applicant has been claimed and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. It has been submitted that this applicant is not named in the F.I.R. This applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been made.

4. On the other hand, learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail stating this this applicant has criminal antecedent and further, the looted vehicle was recovered at the instance of this applicant.

5. Considering the period of custody, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant is directed to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Gumla, in connection with Sisai P.S. Case
