1. I.A. No. 12953 of 2025 is for condonation the delay of four days in filing this appeal.
2. Sufficient cause has been made out. Therefore, the delay in filing the appeal is condoned and I.A. No. 12953 of 2025 stands disposed of.
3. I.A. No. 591 of 2026 is for interim relief.
4. The learned counsel for the appellant states that the entire awarded amount together with interest has already been deposited before this Court.
5. Considering the above statement, the execution of the impugned Award is stayed. I.A. No. 591 of 2026 is disposed of.

6. The stay order will not preclude the claimants from applying for withdrawal of the disbursed amount. Such application, as and when made, will be considered on its own merits.
7. The appeal is admitted.
8. Call for the records and proceedings from the Trial Court.
9. The 1<sup>st</sup> respondent i.e. the claimant must, by the next date, provide the details of the daughter of the deceased. This information must be supplied within 15 days from today so as to enable the learned counsel for the appellant to implead this daughter as a respondent in this appeal.
10. Until such information is supplied, there is no question of the present claimant filing any application for withdrawal of the compensation amount. This is because the learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that this claim petition was filed by the son of the deceased with a statement that his sister i.e. the daughter of the deceased is not interested in receiving any compensation. Therefore, it is required to be ascertained whether this statement was correct.
11. The matter to be placed on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2026 for further consideration.
