Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Lalmatiya P.S. Case No. 48 of 2025, for the offences registered under Sections 152, 153, 191(2), 191(3), 190, 109, 326(f), 115(2), 111, 310(2), 132, 351(2), 352, 61(2) of the B.N.S., 2023, pending in the court of Sri Satish Kumar Munda, learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Godda.

On 12.06.2025 at about 1:00 P.M., one Ashok Kumar was waylaid by 8-10 unknown persons near Babupur village. The accused persons snatched his purse containing Rs. 3,000/- and also set ablaze his Hywa. The police party on the basis of confidential information reached the place of occurrence and came to know that the occurrence was committed by Surya Hansda gang.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that name of the petitioner has transpired on basis of confidential information. It was further submitted that no independent witness has come forward to show complicity of the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid facts, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of Sri Satish Kumar Munda, learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Godda or his successor, in connection with Lalmatiya P.S. Case No. 48 of 2025.
