1. The instant writ application was preferred by the petitioner for quashing the notification dated 24.07.2024, which relates to the petitioner's transfer whose name figures at Sl. No. 73, whereby the petitioner was

transferred from the post of Circle Officer Chatra to Circle Officer Pandu, Palamau. Thereafter, the case was posted on 24.09.2024, and the co-ordinate Bench of this Court has stayed the order of transfer.

2. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the order was stayed for the reason that there was election announced in between; however, now he wants to join the transferred post and further since he is not getting regular salary, therefore the respondents may be granted to verify the case and pay the arrears of the salary.
3. Ld. Counsel for the respondents submits that due to said order passed by this Court, the petitioner could not join the transferred post and now if the petitioner seeks permission to join the said place of posting, then they have no objection.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that record will be verified and if the salary is not paid to the petitioner, his grievance shall be redressed in accordance with law.
5. Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the instant writ application stands disposed of by directing the petitioner to join the transferred post i.e. post of Circle Officer, Pandu, Palamau within a period of 2 weeks from the date of receipt/production of copy of this order.
6. The respondents are further directed to verify the records of the case and pay the admitted salary to the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks.
7. Accordingly, the writ application stands disposed of.
8. Pending IA (s)' also stand disposed of.
