1. Twice, the matter has been taken up. In the second round, Mr. Shashank Shekhar, learned counsel has submitted that he has got fresh Vakalatnama from Mr. Deepankar, learned counsel, after getting NOC which he intends to file, therefore, he has submitted that the matter may be taken up at 2:15 p.m.
2. Considering his prayer, the matter is being adjourned to be taken up at 2:15 p.m.

3. Mr. Shashank Shekhar, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has filed fresh *Vakalatnama*.
4. The case has been filed/instituted on 02.09.2025.
5. The matter was placed before the learned *Lawazima* Board on 08.10.2025 whereby two weeks' time was allowed to the learned counsel to remove the defect as pointed out by the office note dated 25.09.2025, failing which, the case may be placed before the *Lawazima* Board of Registrar (Judicial) once again as per

Standing Order No.14 of 2024 dated 03.10.2024.

6. The case has again been listed on 19.03.2026 in pursuant to the order passed on 08.10.2025 by the learned *Lawazima* Board but on that date, none has represented the petitioner. However, two weeks' time was allowed to the learned counsel to remove the defect as pointed out by office note dated 14.03.2026, failing which, the case may be placed before the Hon'ble Bench having roster for necessary orders as per Standing Order No.14 of 2024 dated 03.10.2024.
7. Office note dated 10.08.2026 reflects that the defect is still surviving.
8. Learned counsel for the petitioner has sought for two weeks' time to remove the surviving defect.
9. Accordingly, two weeks' time is being granted to remove the defect.
10. Office is directed to place this case immediately after two weeks under the appropriate heading.
