Heard Mr. A.K. Kashyap, the learned senior counsel appearing for the appellant and Mr. Shiv Shankar Kumar, the learned APP for the State.

The prayer for bail of the appellant was earlier rejected in I.A. No. 8411 of 2022.

It has been submitted by the learned senior counsel for the appellant that the fire was shot at the spur of moment and the appellant has remained in custody for about 4 ½ years.

Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail of the appellant.

It appears that pistol was recovered on the disclosure of the appellant and the bullet recovered from the person of the deceased was fired from the pistol recovered from the possession of the appellant. It further appears that there is evidence of the eye-witnesses who have seen the appellant firing upon the deceased.

In view of the aforesaid, we are not inclined to reconsider the prayer for bail of the appellant. Accordingly, prayer for bail of the appellant is once again rejected.

I.A. No. 4995 of 2024 stands rejected.
