Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with
Bariyatu P.S. Case No. 39 of 2026 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 111(3), 111(4), 308(4), 308(5), 61(2) of the
B.N.S., 2023 and Sections 25(1-B)(a), 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation
against the petitioner is that while the petitioner being the member of
an organized gang of criminals known as Rahul Singh Gang,
assembled near Duggu Industries Stone Crusher for planning
criminal activities. It is next submitted that the allegation against the
petitioner is false. It is then submitted that police conducted a raid
and apprehended the petitioner with the co-accused persons but
during the search, two live cartridges were recovered from the
possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner
has been in custody since 21.06.2026 as mentioned in para-01 of the
instant bail application. It is next submitted that the case is next fixed
to 10.09.2026 for police papers. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner
undertakes to co-operate with the trial of the case and also undertakes
not to annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner
during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner

be released on bail.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Latehar in connection with Bariyatu P.S. Case No. 39 of 2026 **with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.**
