as the learned counsel appearing for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Nimiyaghat P.S. Case No.36 of 2023, for the alleged offences
registered under Sections 379/414 of Indian Penal Code and Section
30(ii) of Coal Mines Act pending in the Court of learned J.M. 1st
Class, Giridih.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner was carrying 5 quintals of coal on the motorcycle for
his personal use and for that the FIR has been lodged. He further
submits that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedents as
disclosed in paragraph No.6 of the petition. On these grounds, he
submits that the anticipatory bail may kindly be granted.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer

and submits that illegally the coal was being carried.

5. Considering that the said coal was being carried by the petitioner for his personal use and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph No.06 of the petition, I am inclined to provide anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is hereby directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today, and in the event of his surrender/arrest, the petitioner, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Giridih in connection with Nimiyaghat P.S. Case No.36 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
